Experience health science in action through an immersive, hands-on dissection workshop featuring the cardiovascular, visual, and nervous systems. Using Carolina's preserved sheep heart and brain and cow eye specimens, participants will not only explore structure-function relationships, but also experience the power of Activities in a Pinch —bringing complex health science concepts to life through tangible, real-world application.

Rooted in the engagement strategies, this session demonstrates how to craft powerful instructional "hooks" that spark curiosity before the scalpel ever touches the specimen. Educators will rotate through guided dissections to identify key anatomical structures, trace blood flow and neural pathways, and connect anatomy to clinical relevance and health careers. Along the way, participants will model ready-to-use classroom engagement strategies, formative learning checks, and memorable reinforcement activities.

Aligned with the National Health Science Standards, this session equips educators with practical tools to elevate anatomy and physiology instruction —transforming lessons from passive content delivery into interactive, standards-aligned experiences that drive deeper understanding, retention, and career connections.
